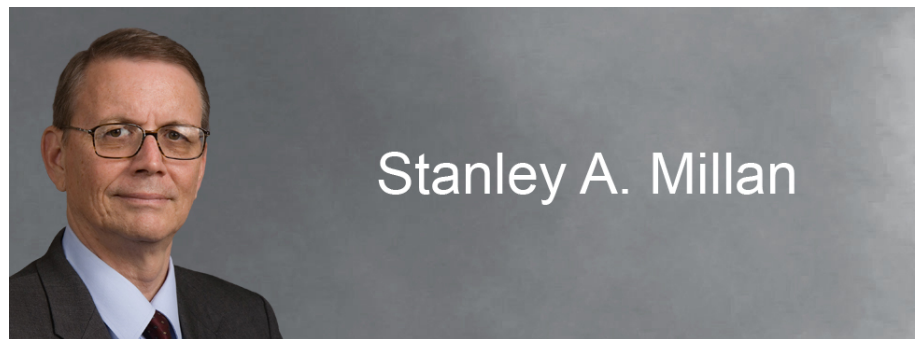

His government contracts work includes small business issues, bid protests, contract dispute claims, and negotiations of equitable adjustments.

Mr. Millan teaches environmental law classes, including pollution law and coastal law seminars that cover the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), wetlands, the Oil Pollution Act (OPA), the Endangered Species Act, and Coastal Zone Management, as an adjunct professor at both the Loyola University New Orleans College of Law and Tulane University Law School. He is also the primary author of *Louisiana Environmental Compliance Louisiana Practice Series*—the only annually published treatise dedicated solely to Louisiana environmental law issues, and he is the only practicing Doctor of Juridical Scientist (environmental law) in Louisiana.

Mr. Millan's government contract practice involves the U.S. Department of Energy, the Department of Defense, NASA, MARAD, and representation of both service contractors and GOCO facility contractors. His practice includes proposal preparations advice, bid protests, and Contract Disputes Act claims.
