He has developed client comments submitted to government authorities on legislative and regulatory proposals affecting oil and gas and mining operations. He has also authored e-business arrangements, agreements, and procedures for auctioning copper concentrates.

Additionally, Mr. Strait prepares ocean shipping agreements for the worldwide delivery of copper concentrates and other products, and he routinely prepares a wide variety of other agreements to facilitate client operations, such as services and operating agreements; agreements for the purchase of goods, equipment, and materials; joint venture agreements; surface leases; and processing agreements.
